3) THE EVENT

- 3.1 Venue: 3 Brothers Road, 15kms east of Roxburgh, Central Otago
 - Coming from North (Alexandra/Cromwell), In Roxburgh, turn onto Jedburgh Street Turn right onto Teviot Road, travel 9 kms, then turn left onto Loop Road then turn left onto 3 Brothers Road.
 - Coming from South (Lawrence), Turn right onto the bridge at Millers Flat, Left turn onto Teviot Road travel 7 kms then turn right onto Loop Road and Right onto 3 Brothers Road

3.2 Surface: Gravel

3.3 Start time: Road Closed 8:00am, Documentation & Scrutineering 8:15am - 9am, Drivers Briefing 9.30am (compulsory) will be given instructions on procedures and format for the day, Roll-Call to be taken at drivers briefing, Indian File 10 am, First Run to follow.

3.4 Finish time: The event will conclude by 5:00 pm (Road Closure Requirements)

3.5 Runs: Overall results for this event will be posted with the winner being the person with the fastest time of the day, the overall result will be taken from the results of completed official runs.

Should the event be stopped prior to the end of an official run then the last completed run will be used for results purposes.

The number of officially timed runs in the event will be dependent on the amount of time available to organisers and/or at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course

Missed times or red flagged laps will be re-run at the end of each run or at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

4) 4. ENTRIES

4.1 Opening and Closing:

Entries will be received until 5:00 pm Friday 13th April 2018

Late entries will be received until 5:00 pm Friday 20th April 2018 – Late entry fee will apply.

4.2 Entry Acceptance:

Entries to be made on the correct form and to be deemed valid must be complete in all detail and accompanied by the appropriate fees. Acceptance will be at the organising committee's discretion. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

Entries will be limited to forty five (45) Max 2 Drivers per car.

4.3 Fees: Appropriate fee payable at the time of entry.

- 4.7 Postponement, Cancellation, Abandonment: The organisers reserve the right to cancel or abandon the Meeting or part thereof, under Force Majeure.
- 4.8 Refund Policy: The organisers advise that entry fees will only be refunded in full or part under the following conditions:
- A) Cancellation of the meeting PRIOR to the commencement of documentation Full refund.
- B) Withdrawal prior to the commencement of Documentation Full refund.
- C) Withdrawal prior to commencement of first official run 50% refund
- D) For reasons of Force Majeure should an Event or part thereof be cancelled any entry fee refund will be made only at the discretion of the organisers.

5) COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY / REQUIREMENTS

5.1 Compliance:

All competing vehicles shall comply with Appendix Two Schedule A & Schedule AA (pre-1978) of the current Motorsport Manual (available online at www.motorsport.org.nz). This is a Clubsport advanced event: Roll protection is required.

5.3 Classes: Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

Class A 0-1600cc Class B 1601-2000cc Class C 2001 & over Class D Classic (C.O.D. Req'd) Class E 4WD

5.4 Competition Numbers: All cars to run with correct driver's numbers clearly visible to the time-keeper. The number to be on both sides of the car (numbers <u>not</u> provided, entrants must have their own). If you have a preferred number ensure this is included on your entry form (pre-entry recommended to secure preferred numbers).

6) SERVICE VEHICLES, PARKING, ETC

Please park where directed by any event official. Please ensure you and your crew arrive, exit and conduct yourselves at the venue without noise or behaviour that might irritate residents or the public. Please ensure that no rubbish left behind by you or your crew. Toilets are available in the pits and finish parking area, there will be food available, please support.

7) DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT

Competitors must present themselves at Documentation for the checking of all licences and documents and applicable advertising material prior to presenting the car for Scrutineering. Documentation and Scrutineering will be on the day from 8:15 am at the pit area for the event.

8) POST EVENT REFRESHMENTS

There will be no prize giving, however after the event, the club will be going to the Miller's Flat Tavern for drinks, All competitors are welcome to attend.
